



How to travel to the Zlatna Greda? Zlatna Greda is 30 km from Osijek and the Osijek average you need about 35 minutes by car. You have more than one direction from which you can get to Zlatna Greda, you can see them on our map of the area. We recommend you come with a bicycle through the Kopacki Rit. You will enjoy the scenery and nature!

What kind of clothes do you suggest for the school in nature? For the school in nature it would not be bad for pupils to have long legs and sleeves, because of the unpredictable weather, it is especially good for the children to be dressed in layers so they are able to easily adapt to weather conditions. It is also advisable to have spare clothes.

Should we bring materials for workshop within the school in nature? Everything you need for the workshop is provided and the cost of materials is included in the total cost of the school in nature.

Is there a possibility that we'll see wild animals? Kopacki Rit and Zlatna Greda are abundant with wild fauna. Although this is not the Zoo, and we can not 100% promise that you will see them, almost all of our groups have seen some part of the fauna (birds, deer, wild boar ...). And it's usually much more than they have ever seen in nature before.

When is the best time for visit? All year round. Each season has its own beauty. In our Season calendar you can find out more about this.

What about the flood season? Flood season is usually in the end of April and throughout the May when the snows melts in the Alps. But weather conditions are unpredictable in recent years, so floods occurred even in summer and autumn.

Do floods mean that we can't do some activities? For some activities we have to do some changes in programmes. But for some programmes like canoes (canoeing through the woods, hiking, fishing in the flooded swamp boots ...) this is the most attractive period.

What about the mosquito season? Mosquitoes are one of the inhabitants of wetland and can sometimes be unpleasant. However, in these circumstances, we give our guests a hat with mosquito nets. It is good to bring cream and spray against mosquitoes and you will be safe. We will alert you and prepare you while you are making your reservation if the mosquito season.

How to dress and what to bring for walking tours, safaris, canoes or boats? Sports and outdoor clothing, depending on the season. It is always good to bring a light jacket against the rain or wind, and the undershirt or shirt for a replacement after an active day.

I have never paddled in a canoe, is there a program for me? We will arrange for you canoe tour so that you will enjoy and be safe. You will learn to paddle in a canoe.

Do we have to worry about our safety in the canoe? We equip our guests with a professional guide and safety vests so that visitors are fully insured.

We are a family and have young children. If we go on safari or any other content that you have is there a parallel program for kids? Our guides are trained to work with children. We will engage children in games and other contents.

We would like to prepare the food for ourselves. Do you have that option? The Eco Centre has a furnace, and all necessary utensils (plates, kettle, barbecues, wood ...) that will be available for you. Our guides can help you in the preparation.

What if it rains? Groups can be provided with a rain cloak, and we can organize a program adapted to weather conditions.
